## **Playing with sleeping dragons**

I will summarize the recent work of my laboratory on sleep in Australian bearded dragons. Our results concern REM and NREM, the involvement of the claustrum, the interhemispheric coordination of sleep, and sleep rhythm generation. This summary can serve as a source for discussion about the mechanisms underlying sleep in amniotes, about homology and about the evolution of sleep.
